

Students for Inclusive Communities Photo Competition

Through photography, this competition raises public awareness in the environmental justice areas and celebrates youth empowerment.

Images submitted to the competition must be related to the environmental justice focus areas

1. Civic Engagement
2. Prioritizing Investments in Underserved Communities
3. Physical Activity/Public Facilities
4. Food Access
5. Safe and Sanitary Housing
6. Pollution - Air Quality/Water/Toxic Substances

Submissions must also include

1. Description about who is affected and why
2. Tagged location and date
3. Potential solutions
